School Trips	More reminders Late texts Cost Safeguarding	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School will endeavour to try to inform parents in a more timely fashion. This includes sending letters home and texts regarding events and activities in school. • All school visits and trips are approved by Derbyshire County Council using an online system called EVOLVE. • With regards any visits and trips we ensure that all Safeguarding procedures are adhered to and that child to adult ratios are enforced and indeed school always sends more adults to ensure the safety of our children. • Payment cards will issued for all trips where payment is required. • Parent Meetings will be held during the spring term for those children in KS2 booked to go on the residential visits; we should have noted this on the initial letter.



Information	Can parents have a noticeboard?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We have installed a new board on the wall to the right of the entrance gate. This will be updated periodically.
Golden Time	Rewards Sanctions Stampers Credits	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> As part of the Brockley Way we are trying to develop and improve behaviour across school. Credits are available to children in KS2 to encourage them to think about the behaviour and earn the opportunity to take part in the residential. The Golden Time rewards are to be revisited in the spring term as it is felt by staff and children that they are not fun enough.
Homework diaries	What are the rules? Marked/Results for homework?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Staff to discuss and ensure whole school approach to homework is shared and followed by all.
Children in Cars	Booster seats	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All children where it is required by law travel with a booster seat.
Uniform	Standards appear to be slipping	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At this time of the year children have grown and a small minority appear not to be wearing school uniform. All parents have been approached and have informed staff that over Christmas new shoes and uniform will be purchased. From January 2016 slips will be sent home reminding parents about the uniform policy.
Out of hours provision	Could school offer longer after school clubs? Could an external provider be approached?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> School to send out a questionnaire and research possible options. CR to report back in spring term.
