Express ideas and feelings with confidence.



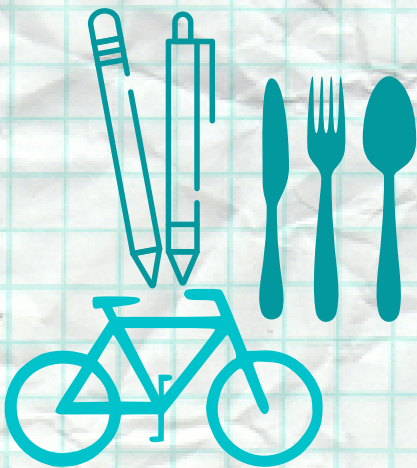
Personal, Social and Emotional Development

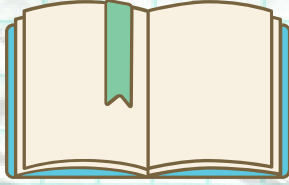
Use cutlery with confidence.

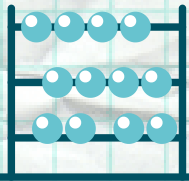


Literacy

Write a simple story.

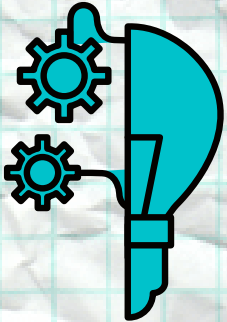


Mathematics
