Thank you to all those who attended the Bug Club meeting last week. We are now at the stage where we can roll out the reading scheme to all children. Your child should have received a bookmark with their login details and over half term teachers will have allocated them a reading book which they can access both in school and at home.

As a school we are encouraging children to access the full range of reading materials using the ActiveLearn platform. However, we appreciate that not all children will have access to a tablet or computer to be able to do this and therefore will still need to take home a reading book.

For children who can access ActiveLearn at home, we are asking parents to opt in to our E readers scheme. This will mean your child will no longer bring home a reading book unless they are in Key Stage 1 who will also be receiving phonics based reading materials. All their reading books will be based on their ActiveLearn account and this should alleviate the previous problems we have had where children have not brought their books in when it is their class reading day or where they have lost them at home.
