Brockley Primary School Uniform Policy

Boys

- Grey or black trousers (smart shorts are permitted in the summer)
- White or red polo shirt
- Red pullover, sweatshirt and/or fleece jackets

Girls

- Grey or black skirt, trousers or pinafore (smart shorts are permitted in the summer)
- White or red polo shirt
- Red jumper, cardigan, sweatshirt and /or fleece jackets

Footwear must be dark coloured and hold the child's foot. Ugg boots, crocs, flip flops or brightly coloured shoes or trainers are not permitted

During summer children are permitted to wear, a red and white gingham check dress.

P.E

- White t-shirt
- Black shorts
- Plimsolls for indoor P.E
- Black jogging bottoms and sweatshirt for outdoor PE (optional)
- Trainers for outdoor P.E
